

ASPHALT CREW MEMBER

Apply asphalt or rock at proper depth, by hand, by using spreader boxes, or machine to obtain proper grade; rakes and shovels asphalt. Establish proper sub-grade and finish grade and prepare holes for patching. Operating the free-floating screed, they level the hot mix to the right thickness and evenness to produce the best roads.

Program:

Construction Craft Workers are multi skilled trades people who prepare, excavate, backfill, and clean up a work site. They learn safe practices and procedures like blueprint reading and worksite communication skills. They will learn procedures for handling equipment and tools safely and for handling construction materials on site. Learn procedures for assembling and dismantling scaffolding, formwork and barricades at construction sites to industry standards of practice and safety standards.
