Environmental Engineering Technicians and Technologists operate, maintain and repair environmental testing equipment. They also monitor emissions and air quality, collect air and/or material samples, analyze data to determine actual and potential health risks. They may also be involved complete reports on how to clean up contaminated sites.

Program:

Environmental technology program emphasizes the construction industry. Topics include: water quality and pollution, municipal solid waste management, environmental site assessment and remediation of contaminated sites and environmental impact of construction projects. Laboratory practice in water quality testing, groundwater movement, environmental audits and the skills needed to analyze and re-mediate the urban environment.
