

PIPE LAYER ASSISTANT

Pipe layer Assistants help pipe layers to lay pipe for storm or sanitary sewers, drains and water mains. They cover pipe with earth or other materials, cut pipes to required lengths and help align and position pipe for welding or sealing. They also dig trenches to the desired depths by hand.

Construction Craft Workers are multi skilled trades people who prepare, excavate, backfill, and clean up a work site. They learn safe practices and procedures like blueprint reading and worksite communication skills. They will learn procedures for handling equipment and tools safely and for handling construction materials on site.
