Apply asphalt or rock at proper depth, by hand, by using spreader boxes, or machine to obtain proper grade; rakes and shovels asphalt. Establish proper sub-grade and finish grade and prepare holes for patching. Operating the freefloating screed, they level the hot mix to the right thickness and evenness to produce the best roads.
