



TRUCK DRIVER

Apply asphalt or rock at proper depth, by hand, by using spreader boxes, or machine to obtain proper grade; rakes and shovels asphalt. Establish proper sub-grade and finish grade and prepare holes for patching. Operating the free-floating screed, they level the hot mix to the right thickness and evenness to produce the best roads.

SKILLS

- Operate and drive straight or articulated trucks, to transport goods and material to destinations
- Oversee condition of equipment, loading and unloading, and safety and security of cargo
- Perform pre-trip inspection/repairs of equipment such as tires, lights, brakes etc.
- Record information, distance traveled, fuel consumption etc. in a log or on on-board computer
- Communicate with dispatcher and other drivers using two-way radio
- Be able to operate vehicles for long periods of time
